- Surgical Hip and Femur Fracture Treatment (SHFFT)
  - Begins July 1, 2017
  - 865 hospitals will participate
  - MS-DRG 480-482
  - CMS expects 109,000 patients enrolled
  - Savings of \$4.9 Billion annually

- Problems with SHFFT
  - Absence of risk adjustment
  - Not all fractures are the same
  - High utilization of postacute care inpatient rehabilitation services for Fracture Patients
