### **Current Charges & Activities**

- 1. Maintenance of the content and format of the grant application
- 2. Present the OTA Board with the requested and approved funding amounts
- 3. Collect progress reports from funded applications on ongoing projects
- 4. Initiate BOS Quality and Patient Safety Action Fund applications
- 5. Establish "New Investigator" grant application and award process.
- 6. Align OTA / OREF combined grant application process so that OTA is fairly represented and our interests are recognized.
- 7. Review membership applications for Research Candidates and Int'l Research
- 8. Develop list of potential multi-center clinical trial projects
- 9. Provide representation and input to the OTA SRI group

## **Strategic Research Initiative Current Charges & Activities**

- 1.SRI works in conjunction with RC to develop strategic topics in orthopaedic trauma research.
- 2. SRI seeks out and vets strategic partnerships with other research entities to leverage new funding.
- 3. SRI works with the Basic Science Committee on topics for presentation at the Basic Science Focus Forum.

### **Current Charges & Activities**

- 4. Suggested new charge: Development of a trauma specific closed soft tissue status classification system (beyond clean, clean contaminated etc)
- 5. Develop Policy re: authorship of papers produced by the committee (consider submitting as future ICL or open forum) (Sunset?)

# Fund Development Committee Current Charges & Activities

- 1. Develop fundraising strategic plan
- 2. Develop database of industry contacts and make contact twice per year (letter, phone call, visit booths at annual meeting) —ongoing
- 3. Coordinate Fundraising events--develop new approaches to inspire member and industry contributions
- 4. Over-see new fund development initiatives (new brochure, industry sessions, etc.)

# **Evidence Based Value and Quality Committee Current Charges & Activities**

- 1. Literature Review: maintain the "best articles" portion of the OTA website with a biannual review of recent literature and incorporation of new evidence.
- 2. Practice Patterns identify current practice patterns and develop consensus guidelines on controversial topics (i.e. Open fxs, DVT, SHS vs CMN, ORIF of clavicle fxs, rehab protocols, etc)
- 3. Quality Metrics Explore and recommend opportunities for the development of Quality Metrics that apply to Orthopaedic Trauma
- a) Time to antibiotics in open fxs
- b) Infection rate of open tibia fxs develop Redcap database for voluntary enrollment of members that can compare their rates to over all rate in database
- c) Hip fx protocols in conjunction w/ AAOs
- 4. Value Explore mechanisms by which the OTA may participate in decreasing the cost of Healthcare while preserving high quality standards.
- a) Decrease practice variation
- b) Increased use of evidence based, protocol-driven care

- c) Define appropriate time for operative interventions, both for immediate care of specific injuries as well as timely diagnosis and intervention for complications. Goal: prevent morbidity and associated costs related to delayed and or inappropriate conservative care.
- 5. Safety- 1) develop "State your Plan" to encourage surgeons to clearly and consistently communicate post op plans. 2) Develop position statement on "Overlapping operations"
