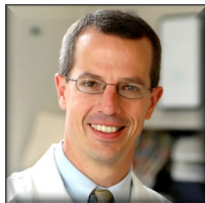
INSTITUTION

- > 4,000 trauma encounters annually
- 4 Helicopters (Care Flight – 35 years of service); 6 mobile ICU ground transports
- Full ancillary service support
- > 150,000 ED visits annually (largest in Ohio)
- Guaranteed orthopaedic trauma room with C-arm, 7 days per week
- Ortho trauma service = 6 attendings; 1 fellow; 3 ortho residents (chief, 3rd year, intern); trauma APN; medical students; occasional other rotators (PLS); Air Force PAs
- 90%+ blunt; 5% mortality; 20% with ISS >16; 8% direct to OR, 25% direct to ICU

POSITION

- One-year adult orthopaedic trauma fellowship – ACGME accreditation 2009-2014; OTA accreditation 2014-present
- Separate orthopaedic trauma call (6 attendings participate), separate hand and spine calls
- Call schedule flexible: Fellow rotates in the “Chief Resident” call schedule
- \$67,829 salary for 2020-2021
- Free parking; free meals; free gym on premises
- Benefits include life insurance; disability; health care coverage
- Outside conference possibilities: OTA, TSF course, 2-3 fellows' courses
- In-house conferences: Daily resident/fellow conferences; comprehensive fracture review (weekly); general surgery trauma collaborative (monthly); regular J club (monthly); fellows conference JOT J club (monthly)
- Involvement in at least 1 research project
