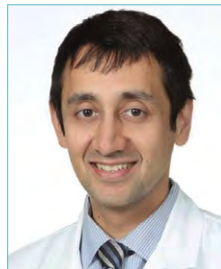
COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Resident Comprehensive Fracture Course will be presented in separate small group modules, with 15-16 residents and 5 experienced faculty educators per module.

The modules will have a rapid-fire series of mini-lectures, an extensive open case-based discussion, video demonstrations of techniques, and hands-on skills lab exercises. Modules will cover fundamental principles of fracture care distributed among topics: articular, diaphyseal, foot and ankle, geriatrics, pediatrics, pelvis/polytrauma/acetabulum, spine and upper extremity.

This course offers pre-course educational on-demand video materials. Details will be sent with registration confirmation as well as an online basic science pre-test and an onsite clinical post test.
