the title slide. If you have relevant disclosures, we ask that you explicitly disclose and explain those relationships at the beginning of your presentation. If the session moderator feels it is needed, they may use the discussion time to ask for further clarification regarding potential conflicts.
Manuscripts for podium presentations will be due in mid-September. This allows moderators to review your podium presentation prior to the meeting. All authors who do not submit a manuscript will be banned from podium presentations or posters at the OTA for two years. Manuscripts should resemble a journal manuscript with developed and detailed Introduction, Methods, Results and Discussion sections. Manuscripts are due September 15.
It is preferred that presenters upload talks through the Speaker Management Site prior to arriving at the annual meeting; an email with upload instructions will be sent mid to late September. Check-in to the speaker ready room at least one hour prior to your talk to preview your presentation, especially if videos are present. After October 11, presenters will be responsible for uploading their presentations onsite in the speaker ready room and must do so 2 hours prior to their talk.
