LEARNING OBJECTIVES

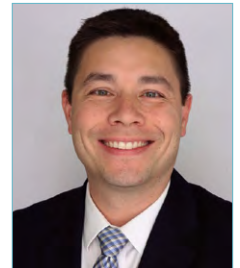
Upon successful completion of the 2023 Orthopaedic Trauma Boot Camp, participants will be able to:
