OVERVIEW

Limited to OTA Members, this Soft Tissue Coverage Skills Course is a hands-on skills lab (cadaver) to teach orthopaedic trauma surgeons techniques in soft tissue coverage. Techniques will focus on skin augmentation and rotational flap coverage for the lower extremity that can be translated into practice. All faculty are Orthopaedic Trauma Surgeons that are active members of the OTA with extensive experience in soft tissue coverage. Entire course takes place in a skills lab.




