IOTA at the 2023 OTA Annual Meeting



The Orthopaedic Trauma Association's 39th Annual Meeting took place at the original Seattle Convention Center, Arch Building located at 705 Pike Street in Seattle, Washington with 1,753 attendees and more than 400 accomplished orthopaedic trauma surgeon presenters, moderators, and authors sharing their expertise, experience and perspectives.

It was another successful year for the International Trauma Care Forum that took place at the OTA 2023 Annual Meeting in Seattle. Over 120 attendees took part in this 1.5 day session. 32 scientific papers were selected with topics focused on: upper extremity, geriatric, pelvis/acetabulum, lower extremity and general interest.

In addition to the papers, there were 5 symposia presented:

- Proximal Humerus: Treatment Controversies
- Tibial Plateau Fractures, featuring presenters from the 2023 Guest Nation, Spain
- IOTA Symposium: Trauma Systems: A Global Comparison, This enlightening session had 10 speakers from 5 continents
- Pelvis/Acetabulum: Management of Geriatric Injuries
- Managing Difficult Fractures in Resource Limited Settings Using SIGN Nails, featuring 2
 presenters from our second Guest Nation, South Sudan.


The Guest Nation Experience: Spain
