## **IOTA Symposium at ECTES 2024**

The European Society for Trauma and Emergency Surgery (ESTES), a surgical society comprised of orthopaedic and general surgeons, organizes its annual conference ECTES throughout Europe in the spring. ESTES has partnered with the IOTA to sponsor a session since 2022. Frank Hildebrand, President of ESTES, and Chris Pape and KJ Ponsen, representatives of the IOTA, organized a session on Fracture-Related Infections (FRI) at this year's annual meeting in Estoril, Portugal. The symposium emphasized Diagnostics and Treatment Modalities – a topic previously covered in an IOTA Symposium at the 2022 OTA Annual Meeting in Tampa, FL. As a member of the ESTES advisory committee EAC and FIOTA member, I used the IOTA network to engage speakers from European IOTA societies, some of whom were attending ECTES for the first time. The symposium, moderated by Chris Pape and Guy Putzeys, consisted of four presentations and two case discussions:

- State of the art in diagnostics of FRI by Nikolaos Kanakaris (UK)
- Infected stable intramedullary osteosynthesis by Macarena Lopez (ESP)
- DAPRI protocol in acute FRI of pelvic fractures by Stefano Cattaneo (ITA)
- One stage treatment of FRI with AB impregnated bonegrafts by Guy Putzeys (BE)
- Frank Hildebrandt (GER) and Hiro Minehara (JPN) each presented a challenging case.



The meeting was well attended, interactive, and well received by participants and speakers, as reflected in the following email by one of the speakers:

## **IOTA Observership Testimonial**



Dr. Dimitrios Ntourantonis, MD, MSc was nominated by the Hellenic Association of Orthopaedic Surgery and Traumatology (HAOST) to participate in the 2023 cycle of the IOTA Observership Program, where he matched at the Sunnybrook Heath Sciences Centre at the University of Toronto hosted by OTA member Dr. David Stephen, MD. When asked what encouraged him to participate in the IOTA Observership Program, Dr. Ntourantonis stated, "It was an opportunity for me to broaden my horizons providing me with the chance to expand my knowledge and skills in treating challenging and complex cases." His key takeaways from his observership experience included the holistic care of patients, preoperative planning, cooperation between different specialties and subspecialties, and the training of future doctors. Dr. Ntourantonis' favorite parts of his experience was the observation of difficult

surgical cases and the tips and tricks needed in order to improve the surgical outcome and how to avoid complications in patients.

Overall, Dr. Ntourantonis expressed, "The center I visited is one of the most famous in North America. The facilities of the hospital were in the proper order to provide the best care in difficult trauma cases. The personnel were highly educated and trained in trauma. One of the pitfalls during my visit was the unpredictable schedule in the operation theater even during the weekdays that has to do in my opinion with the organization of the whole security system. Despite that, my final impression is highly positive and I would like to thank IOTA for the opportunity and HAOST (Hellenic Association of Orthopaedic Surgery and Traumatology) for the financial support of this fellowship."

Dr. Dimitrios Ntourantonis, MD, MSc is currently a Consultant in Orthopaedics and Trauma at the University Hospital of Patras in Greece. His research interests are in arthroplasty, major trauma, wrist and hand, and biomechanics.
