

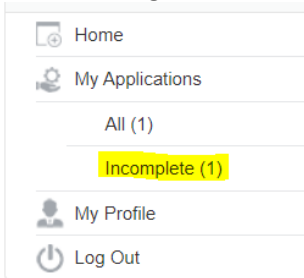


Dear Fellowship Program Directors and Coordinators,

COTA Grant Application is now open – Application closes on January 27, 2025 at 12:00 PM CDT.

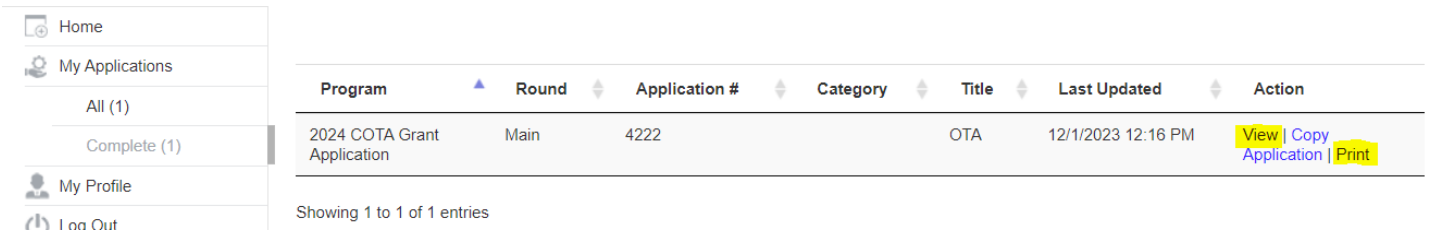
We will be accepting COTA applications via **an online platform**. This is [the link](#) to the COTA 2025 Application.

- To sign in, use the same login credentials as when logging into your OTA profile. Please email occonnell@ota.org or ota@ota.org if you need that information – all program directors and coordinators should have a profile in the OTA database. If you need one created, please email occonnell@ota.org.
- The application will be saved on the profile of the person that creates the submission. If it needs to be shared with others at the institution for review, they will need to be given the login credentials.
- To save your work and/or come back to it later, click save /next at the bottom of each page. Use the same link to log back in and finish the incomplete application and click on incomplete in your profile.



Please review your application and ALL supplementary documentation that is being uploaded to **remove any identifying** information relating to: program name, faculty, fellows. Program letterhead should be **not be used** for submission of any documentation – applications containing any identifying information will not be submitted for review. Please be sure that your application is complete before submitting it.

When the application is submitted, the user will be able to save for a final review before ‘save and finalize.’ After the application has been submitted, you will be able to view and/or print a copy of the final submission.
